Acts 9:36-43 Resurrection Legacy Call her Tabitha – or call her Dorcas, if you happen to favor the Greek. Whatever name you use, understand that she was a pillar of the early church in Joppa, a town which was about 30 miles northwest of Jerusalem.

Resurrection of Dorcas--raised by Peter (Acts 9:36-40) Tabitha in city of Joppa

B. Raising Tabitha (9:36-43) While Peter is in Lydda, there is a disciple named Tabitha in Joppa who was always doing good works and acts of charity. But Tabitha became sick and died. Since the city of Lydda is near Joppa, the disciples in Joppa sent two men begging Peter to come to Joppa.

Commentary on Acts 9:36-43 by Eric Barreto

Acts 9:36 is the only place in the New Testament where the feminine form of the Greek word for “disciple” is used. What do you think that may tell us about the reputation Tabitha or Dorcas had among the believers in her community? Dorcas “was devoted to good works and acts of charity.”

Acts 9:36-43, Stepping Out in Faith: Tabitha and Peter

Acts 9:31 speaks of plural churches in Judea, Galilee, and Samaria. These two cities lie on the Mediterranean coast. Joppa is the modern city of Jaffa, which is part of Tel Aviv. Peter followed Jesus example of healing the paralyzed man at the Pool of Bethesda by saying, “Arise, take up your bed and walk.”
