### Oral Contraceptive Use and Ovarian Cancer

Ovarian Cancer Statistics. Each year, about 20,000 women in the United States get ovarian cancer. Ovarian cancer causes more deaths than any other cancer of the female reproductive system, but it accounts for only about 3% of all cancers in women. When ovarian cancer is found in its early stages, treatment works best.

There is no simple and reliable way to screen for ovarian cancer in women who do not have any signs or symptoms.. Screening external icon is when a test is used to look for a disease before there are any symptoms. Cancer screening tests work when they can find disease early, when treatment works best.

The Cancer and Steroid Hormone (CASH) Study was a population-based, case-control study conducted by eight SEER registries during the 1980s to investigate the relationship between oral contraceptive (OC) use and breast, endometrial, and ovarian cancers among U.S. women.

A study of venous thrombosis during first-line chemotherapy in ovarian cancer identified no difference in stage of disease or PS between the groups with and without thrombosis. Once again the prognosis was worse in the group with thrombosis (median survival 29.8 months (thrombosis) and 36.2 months (no thrombosis)) ( Fotopoulou et al , 2008 ).

The aim of this case-control study is to further assess the association between dietary factors and epithelial ovarian cancer, which accounts for more than 90% of all ovarian malignancies (Cotran et al, 1999).

Case Study #1. Janice At 38 years old, Janice was diagnosed with Stage IIIC ovarian cancer and underwent successful surgery followed by 6 cycles of chemotherapy with carboplatin and taxol. She achieved a complete remission and did well for 18 months before her CA 125 level began rising even though CT scans revealed no evidence of disease.

**Cdc Ovarian Cancer Case Study**

Ovarian cancer is a group of diseases that originates in the ovaries, or in the related areas of the fallopian tubes and the peritoneum. Women have two ovaries that are located in the pelvis, one on each side of the uterus. The ovaries make female hormones and produce eggs.

**Epithelial ovarian cancer: A case report**

An initial analysis of an ongoing, multicenter case-control study indicates that women who have used oral contraceptives are approximately half as likely to develop ovarian and endometrial cancer as women who have never used them and that, despite previous concerns, contraceptive use does not appear to increase a woman's risk of breast cancer.

**Thrombosis in ovarian cancer: a case control study**

We evaluated ovarian cancer risk in relation to sugary foods and beverages, and total and added sugar intakes in a population-based case-control study. Cases were women with newly diagnosed epithelial ovarian cancer, older than 21 years, able to speak English or Spanish, and residents of six counties in New Jersey.
