The LS2 engine was General Motors' first engine in its Generation IV family for its small block V8 engines. This engine was created with a volume of 5.967 L, or more generically 6.0L, slightly larger than the 5.7L L56 engine that it replaced in several models.

The first Gen V LT engine was the LT1, announced in 2012 as the initial powerplant for the redesigned Corvette C7, succeeding the LS engine family. The new logo formally adopts the Small Block name for the engines.

The LS1 engine is a Gen III 5.7L aluminum-block V8 car engine that first appeared in the 1997 Chevrolet Corvette. The LS6—introduced for the 2001 Chevy Corvette Z06—is also a Gen III 5.7 aluminum-block V8. While the LS6 emerged from the factory with more power than the LS1, both engines can make the same power with common upgrades.

A Brief History of The LS1: The LS1 is the spiritual successor to the "small block V8" that GM uses in rear-wheel-drive cars, trucks, and vans. It was introduced in 1995 as the "GEN III" engine and it only shared rod bearings, lifters, and bore spacing with its predecessors (which was in production 1955 until 2003).

The Corvette LS1 Engine

In the Corvette offering, the LS1 was introduced in 1997 with 345 horsepower at 5600 RPM and 350 lb-ft at 4400 RPM. In 2001 the power and torque were increased slightly to 350 horsepower at 6000 RPM and 360 lb-ft of torque at 4000 RPM. The LS1 engine is 5.7 L, or more precisely 346 cubic inches.

The LS1 engine initially produced 345 hp (257 kW), subsequently increased in 2001 to 350 hp (261 kW). The 4L60-E automatic transmission carried over from previous models, but the manual was replaced by a Borg-Warner T-56 6-speed capable of a 175 mph (282 km/h) top speed.
