Ignition Coil Replacement Cost. Replacing the ignition coil is simple, however, if you are not comfortable in doing it yourself, head over to the auto mechanic and let the experts do the job. The average cost to replace the ignition coil is between \$150 to \$270. The ignition coil itself costs approximately \$120 to \$160.

In most cars with a 4-cylinder or inline-6 engine, replacing an ignition coil is a simple and not very expensive job (\$180-\$380 for one coil). In some V6 engines, to gain access to rear ignition coils, an intake manifold must be removed (e.g. Ford Edge, Ford Escape V6, Nissan Murano, Toyota Camry V6).

Many a technician is fooled into replacing a good coil because the coil grounding lead was shorting out against a piece of sheet metal. DO NOT attach the tester to the spark plug for this test. Some coils are constructed in series and called cassette or sequence coils, or coil rails. Where is the coil? The ignition coil sits between the battery and, if the car is an older model, the distributor that 'distributes' the HT voltage it produces to each spark plug, via thick rubbery HT leads (one per plug).

An ignition coil (also called a spark coil) is an induction coil in an automobile's ignition system that transforms the battery's low voltage to the thousands of volts needed to create an electric spark in the spark plugs to ignite the fuel. Some coils have an internal resistor, while others rely on a resistor wire or an external resistor to limit the current flowing into the coil from the car ...
