The 47 ronin, known as Chushingura - the League of Loyal Hearts, were buried near their lord Asano in a temple in Tokyo where their graves exist today. In 1701 two lords were assigned to tend to the emperor's envoys during a visit to the Shogun. The senior lord, Kira, expected gifts from the younger lord Asano for his help in court etiquette.
